REPLACEMENT OF INTERNAL DMS AND ASSOCIATED PORTAL • MIGRATION TO GOFAST



This project, led by teams from the Police Academy, illustrates the successful replacement of an internal DMS with a secure, sovereign open-source platform, ensuring control over sensitive data and continuity of operational services.

A strategic project to modernise document management!

The French Police Academy is a central department under the authority of the Directorate-General of the National Police (DGPN). It replaced the DCRFPN as part of the reorganisation of the National Police. At the end of 2019, a review was launched to replace its internal DMS and the associated portal used to distribute all field procedures and training documents for the National Police. The challenge: Replace this platform, developed internally some fifteen years ago, with a commercially available platform, preferably open-source, with limited specific developments. The new solution must be 'OnPremise' and connected to the Interministerial Network (RIE) so that it is also accessible to the Ministry of the Interior and can be used on NEO 2 smartphones.

The solution: *GoFAST DMS was chosen by the Police Academy because it perfectly matched what they were looking for. GoFAST is open-source with a very powerful functional DMS base, requiring only additional development.*

Precise specifications

The main points of the specifications have been defined:

- Development of job descriptions with metadata and specific management rules
- Concepts of publication status on the portal and approval workflow
- Implementation of an advanced search engine based on metadata
- Intranet portal for field agents to consult records
- Complete migration of files and documents with transfer of existing metadata
- On-premise installation and security counterpart in the Ministry of the Interior's data centre
- Include the key users of the system to be replaced in the project

Despite fairly precise specifications, it was decided to adopt an agile approach to the project and to adhere as closely as possible to the "GoFAST" standard.

A PoC to confirm the choice


At the end of 2022, the National Police assessed GoFAST's ability to replace its internal DMS via a proof of concept.

PoC phase (approx. 10 key users):

- Specific metadata for a category of records (Practical Guides)
- Development of the advanced search engine
- Migration test for standard files

PoC review: GoFAST has confirmed its ability to meet business needs, offering a robust and customised solution.

Major project stages

Once the PoC was completed, the steps were as follows:

- Iterative development over 18 months with regular validations in an integration environment (SaaS)
- CEO-Vision was commissioned to take over and maintain the Portal section, with its scalability challenges
- Installation in the SGAMI (General Secretariat for the Administration of the Ministry of the Interior) data centre in Lyon
- Migration of files and documents and integrity checks
- General revenue collection followed by activation of the service at national level

The objectives achieved

Business adaptation: specific data sheets and metadata meeting operational requirements.

Successful migration: Service continuity and optimised access for field agents.

Reliability: Robust and secure platform, hosted on-premises.

Strategic choice: Reasonable adaptation of a standard GoFAST to optimise development and operating costs.

- Full deployment: September 2025
